GUIDELINES FOR VISITOR PLAY





COURSE MATTERS

Repair all plug marks on the greens. Do not climb the face of a bunker, but enter or leave via a low point of the bunker.

Thoroughly smooth out footprints and all other marks after playing from a bunker. Leave bunker rakes on flat part of the bunker, and lying parallel to the direction of play.

RIGHTS OF WAY

If the pin is removed then the hole is temporarily closed and players must not hit up.

Before hitting-up always wait for acknowledgement by staff that they are aware of your presence.

ETIQUETTE AND SPEED OF PLAY

RESPONSIBILITY

The low marker, in each group is responsible for the observance of the etiquette of the game.

ON THE GREEN

Place buggies close to the path to the next tee and not in front of the green.

CALLING UP

A match that is holding up play, and has a clear hole ahead, must call through the match behind. Matches behind held up under these circumstances have not only a right, but a duty to the field following to play through.

PICKING UP

If a player can no longer effectively participate in a hole, he/she should pick up their ball.

KEEPING UP

The objective of maintaining your place in the field will be achieved if you keep up with the group in front.

DRESS

Golf Attire consists of collared shirts, tailored trousers or shorts and golf shoes.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESS

- Cargo shorts
- Cargo pants
- 3/4 length pants (Men)
- Black or colored socks and socks with markings
- Shirts un-tucked
- Runners
- Denim
- Hats in the clubhouse

MOBILE TELEPHONES

The use of mobile phones either on the course or in the clubhouse and surrounds is not permitted
